Designs might also be required for digital or multi-media.
- Collaborate with colleagues (technical, market research, and writing professionals) to develop effective technology transfer strategies that capitalize on effective use of print media.

- Experience interfacing with print shops to ensure high quality production of designed pieces; demonstrated ability to define required print parameters as piece is designed.
- Experience developing publications that are compliant with Section 508 of the American Disabilities Act (ADA Compliance).
- Experience designing and generating video content using Adobe Director, Fireworks, Flash, Final Cut Pro (or Express), and/or other graphic/video movie tools preferred.
- Experience working independently, preferably in a virtual office environment.
- A fully functioning home office space, including a Windows or Macintosh computer (Macintosh preferred), high-speed Internet connection, business telephone line, Microsoft Office software, and a license for Adobe Creative Suite (CS3 or later).
